

HOUSE RULES  
AMERICAN LEGION POST69 AND THE "AMCAN" LOUNGE

1. The following shall be admitted:
  - a. All members of the American Legion and Auxiliary and SAL showing current membership card and their escort.
  - b. All Foreign Legion members showing a current membership card and all domestic military personnel in uniform.
  - c. Non- members of the American Legion, Auxiliary and SAL as guest, when accompanied by a member in good standing. Guest are required to obey the guest rules posted.
2. Legionnaires and guest are requested to help keep the Post Home and grounds clean and tidy. Please use the ash trays for matches and cigarette butts.
3. The Steward and employee on duty shall have full authority to enforce HOUSE RULES and may eject any member or guest for misconduct or violation of Club rules. The member ejected shall have the right to appeal to the Executive Committee.
4. No member shall reprimand an officer or employee of the American Legion. Any suggestions or criticisms of the Lounge or Legion operation shall be submitted to the proper committee.
5. The attendant on duty may refuse service to anyone.
6. Any member removing, damaging or destroying any property of the American Legion shall pay for the damage.
7. Cashing of checks over \$25, credit or lending of Lounge funds is prohibited. Checks cashed only on approval of Post Officer.
8. The Lounge will remain open to all Foreign members & Guest during General meetings but will be closed to Post 69, Auxiliary and SAL members. No drinks shall be carried into the General meeting.
9. No intoxicated members will be tolerated in the Lounge.
10. There shall be no drinks of any kind taken from the premises.
11. Positively no alcoholic drinks are to be served to minors.
12. Dogs or other pets will not allowed in the Lounge except for assisted animals.
13. Loud, boisterous or profane language will not be tolerated in Post Home or anywhere on it's property.

14. The Lounge will close at stipulated hours, unless there are special occasions, at which time the House Committee may grant an extension.

15. Social quarters will be closed on any day as deemed advisable by the House Committee.

16. Suspension periods are:

1<sup>st</sup> Offense-Letter of reprimand

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense-30 days suspension

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense-60 days suspension

4<sup>th</sup> Offense-90 days suspension

5<sup>th</sup> Offense-PERMANENT SUSPENSION
